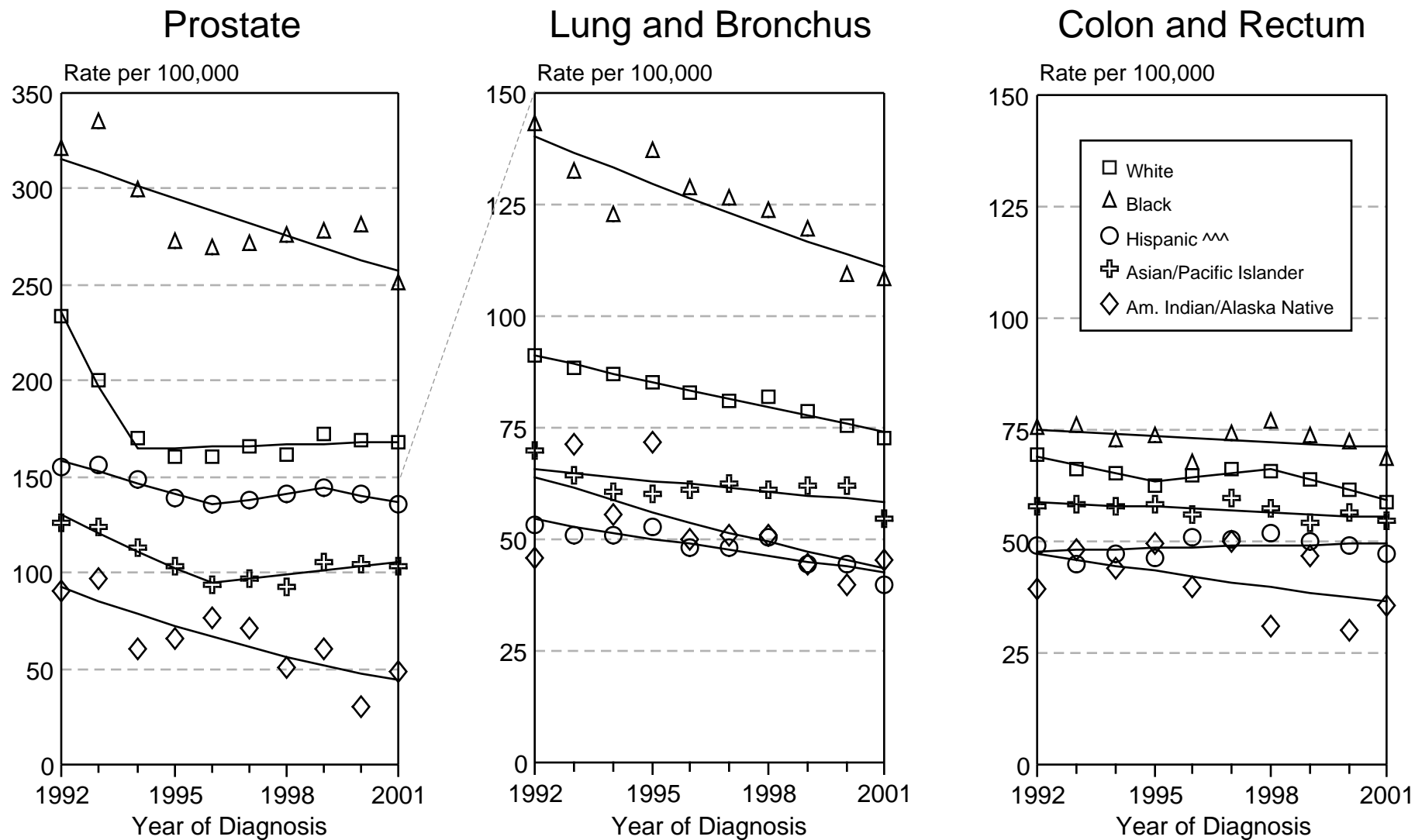

SEER Incidence 1992-2001 Females by Race/Ethnicity

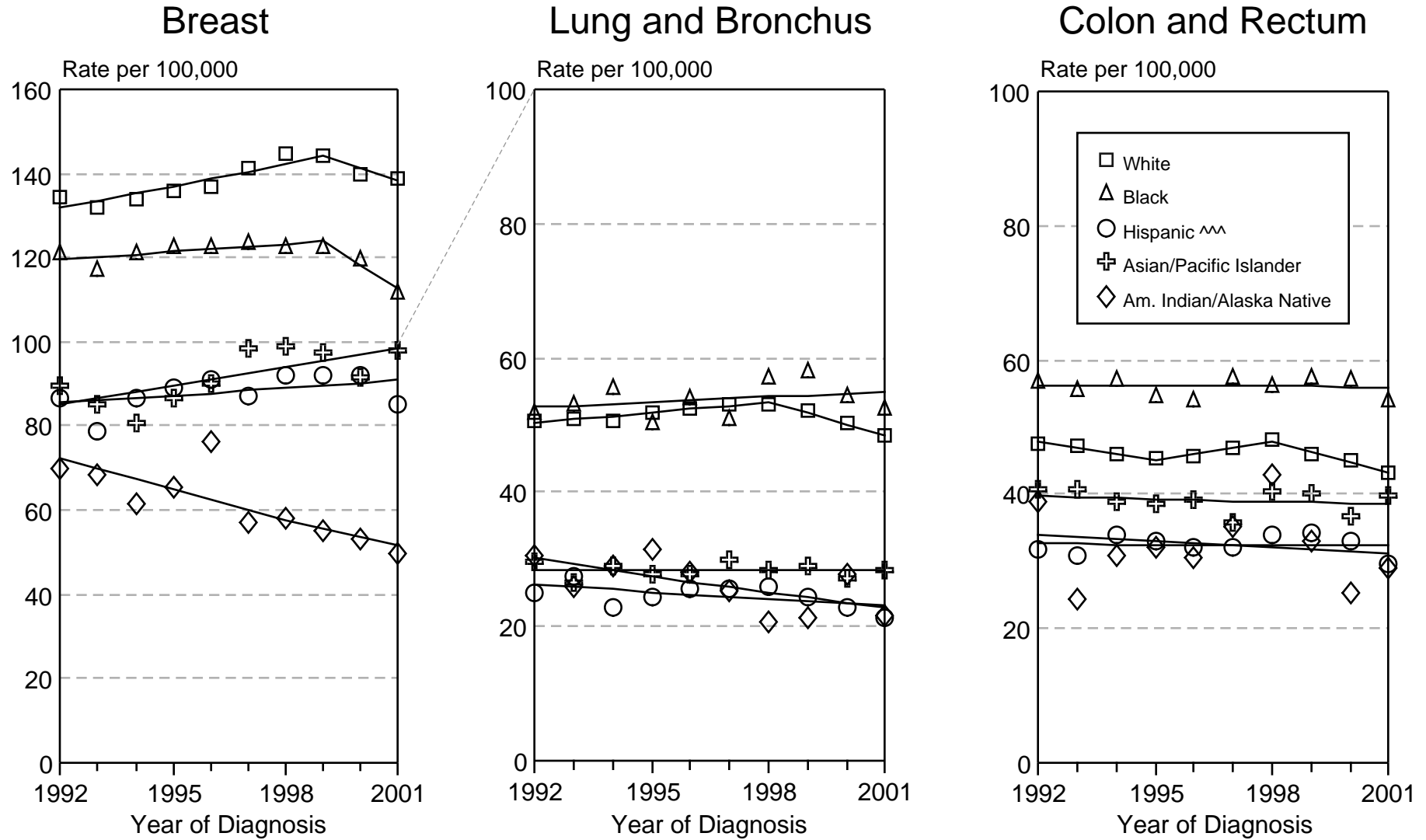
