


Did You Know? Video Series

The Did You Know? Video Series provides 2- to 3-minute informational videos on various cancer topics. The videos communicate key statistical data on different types of cancers to a lay audience in understandable, clear, and concise language. Each video also provides background information on cancer types and risk factors, and encourages action when appropriate.

Statistical Features in Videos:

- New diagnoses (incidence) for one year
- New diagnoses, multiple years
- New diagnoses by race/ethnicity and/or sex
- 5-year survival
- 5-year survival by cancer stage
- 5-year survival over time
- Death rates (mortality) by race/ethnicity and/or sex
