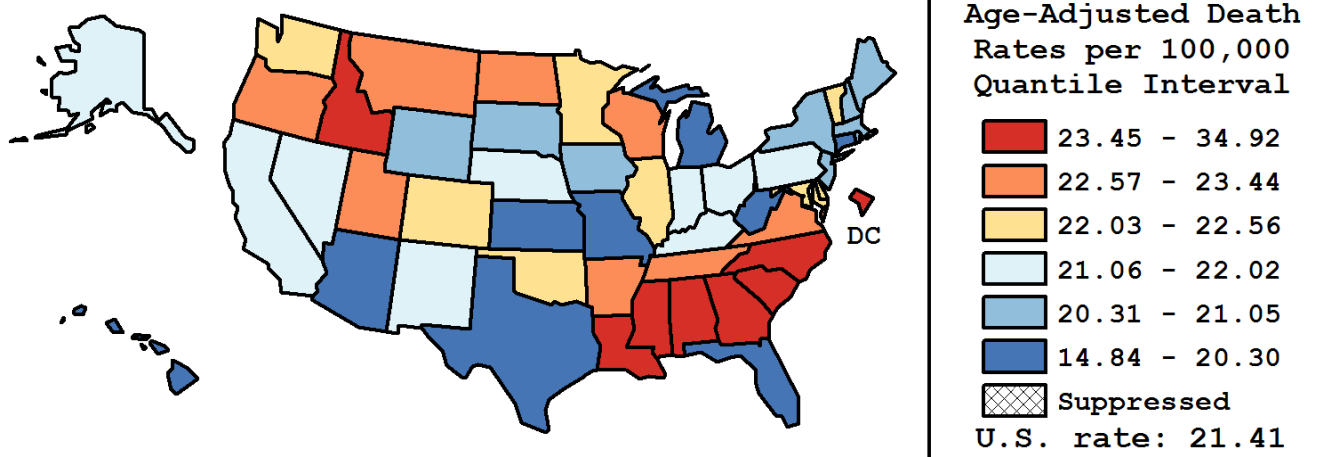

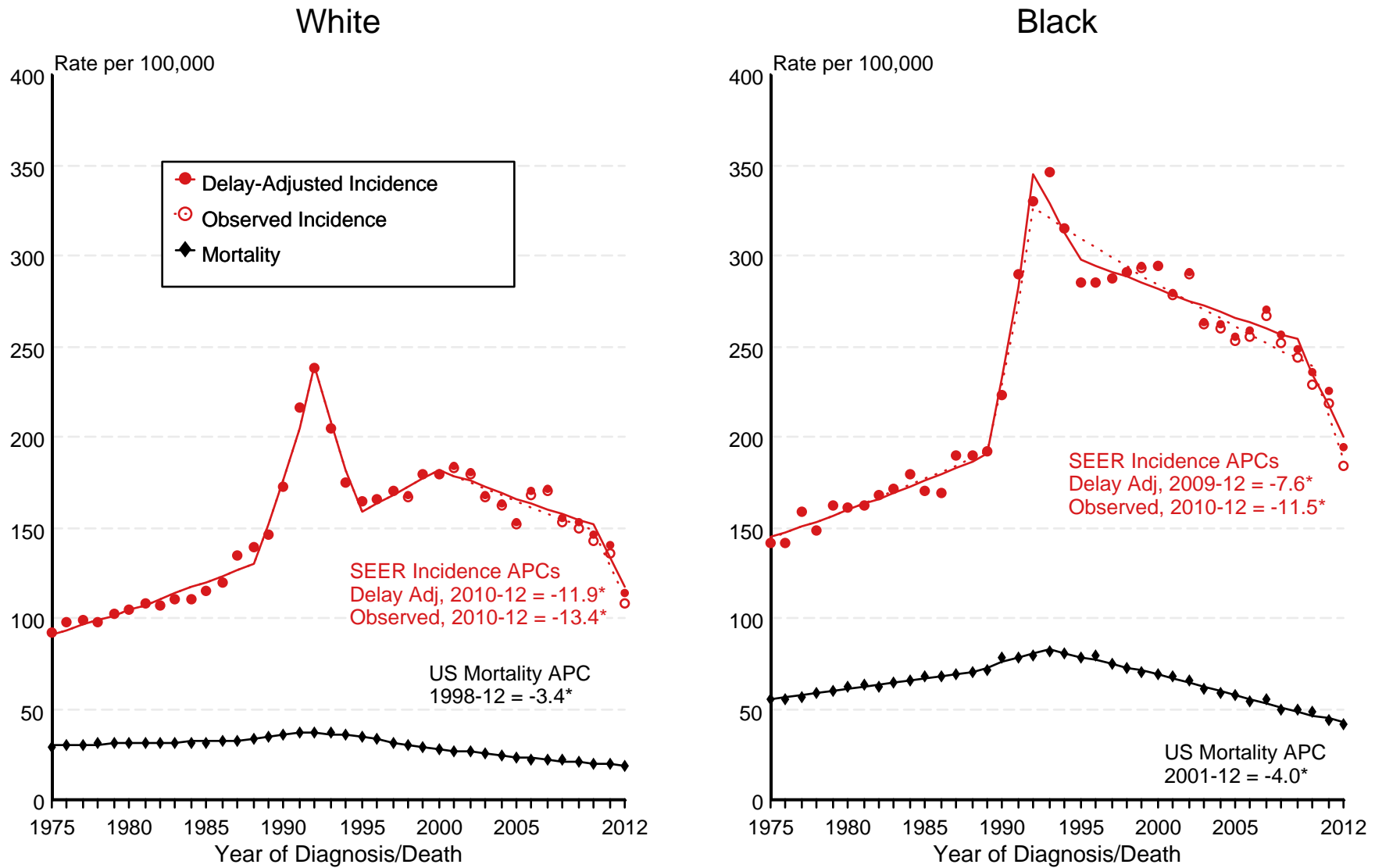

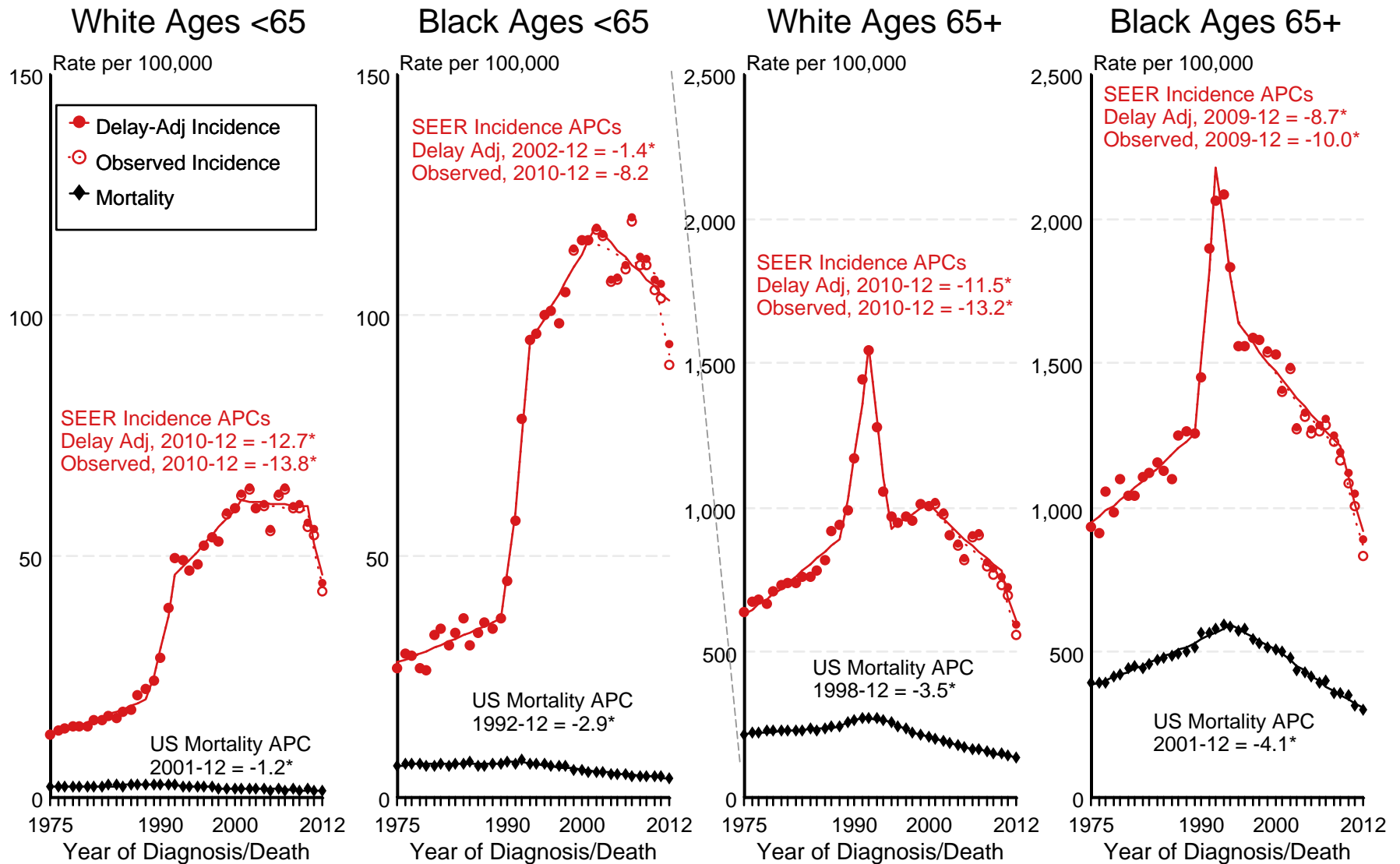

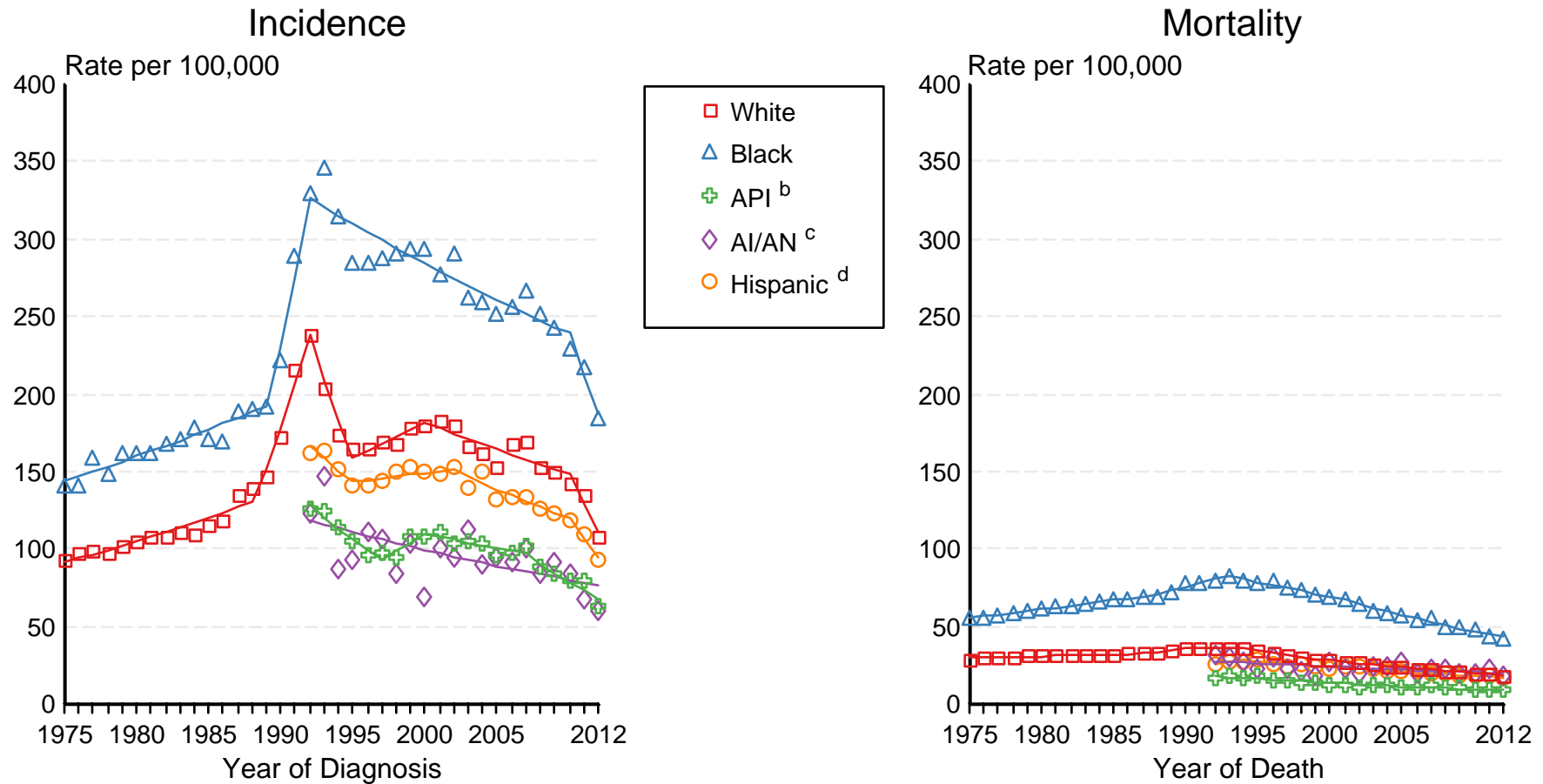

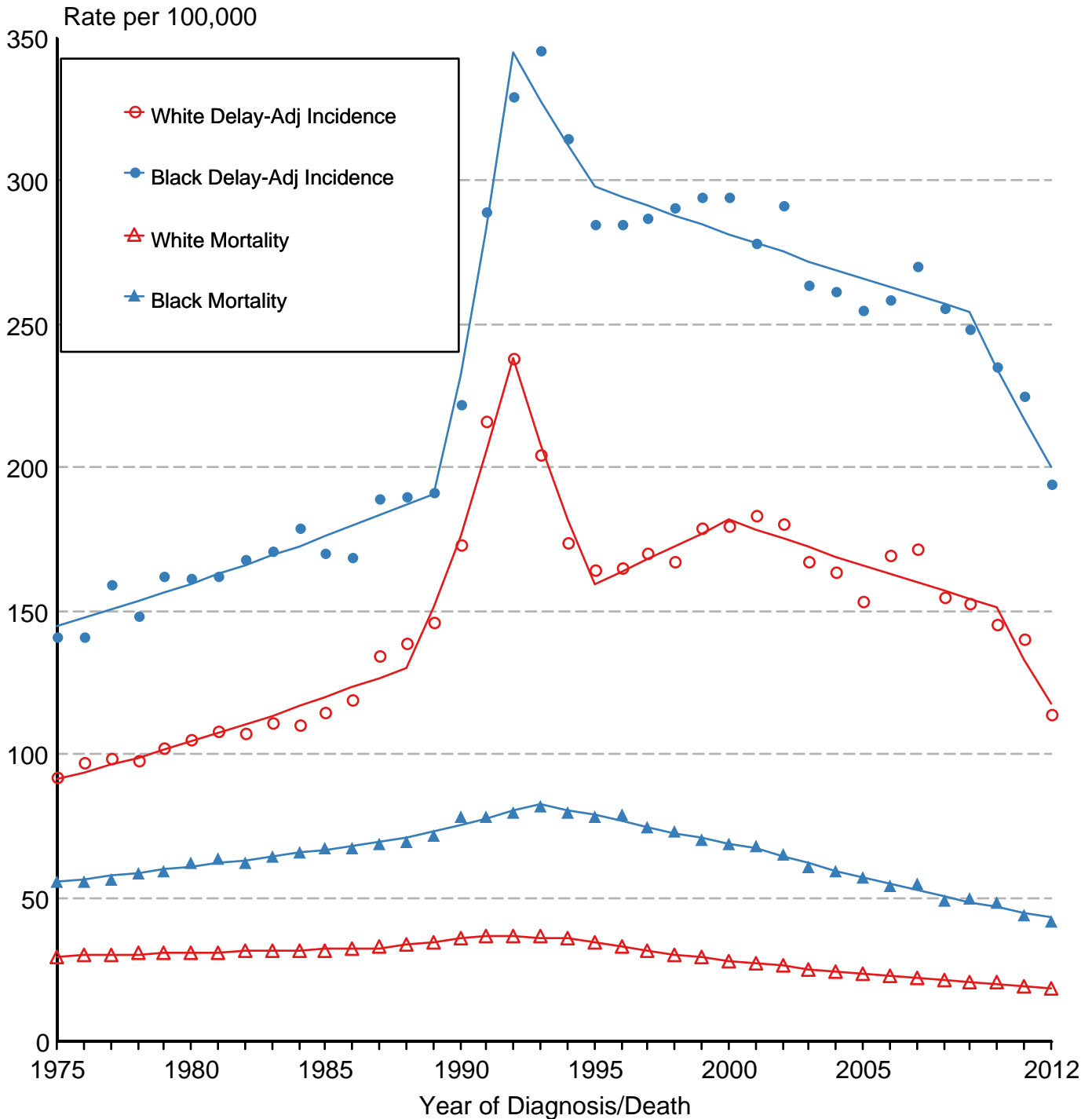

Cancer of the Prostate

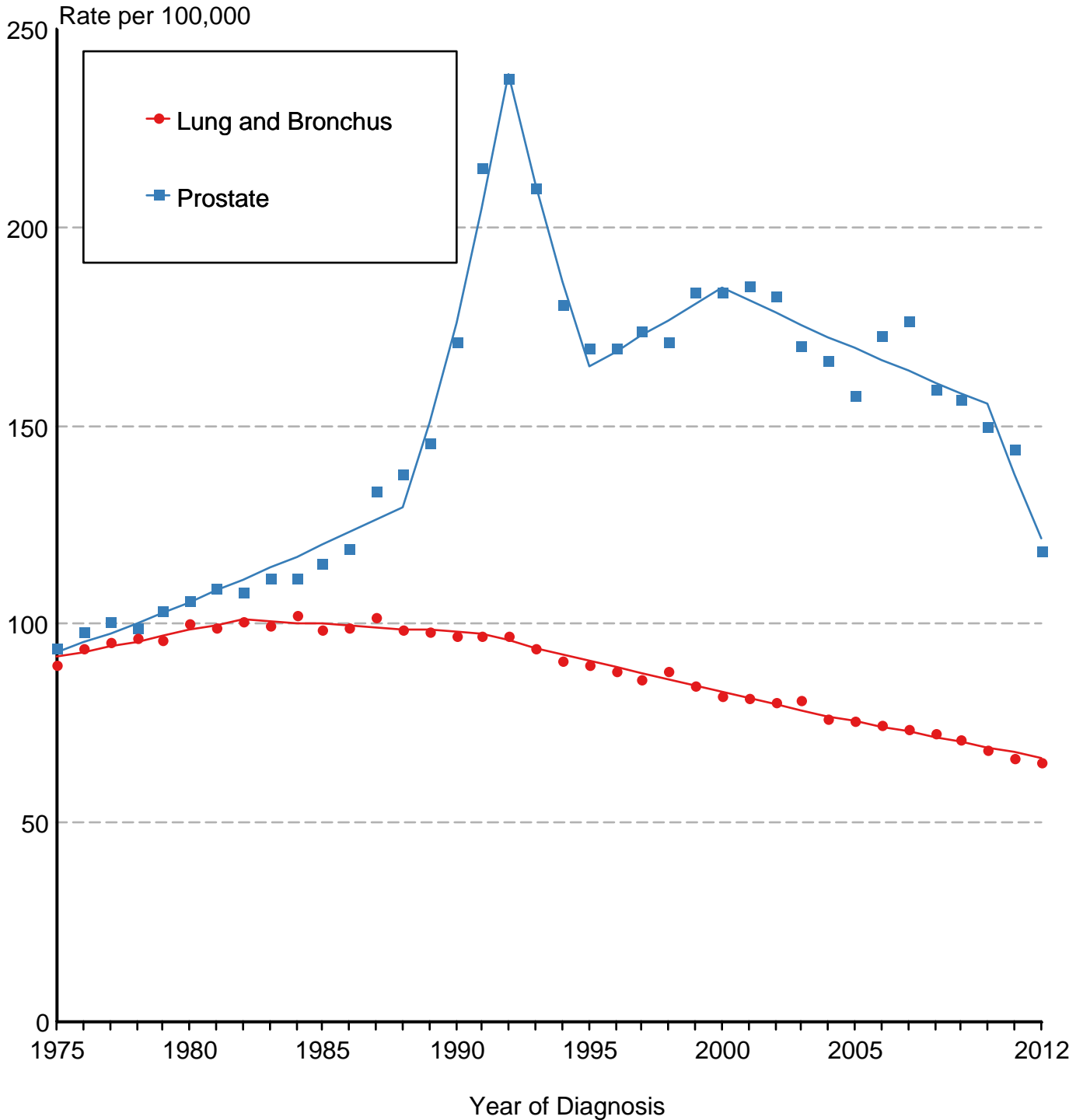
Delay-Adjusted SEER Incidence & US Mortality 1975-2012

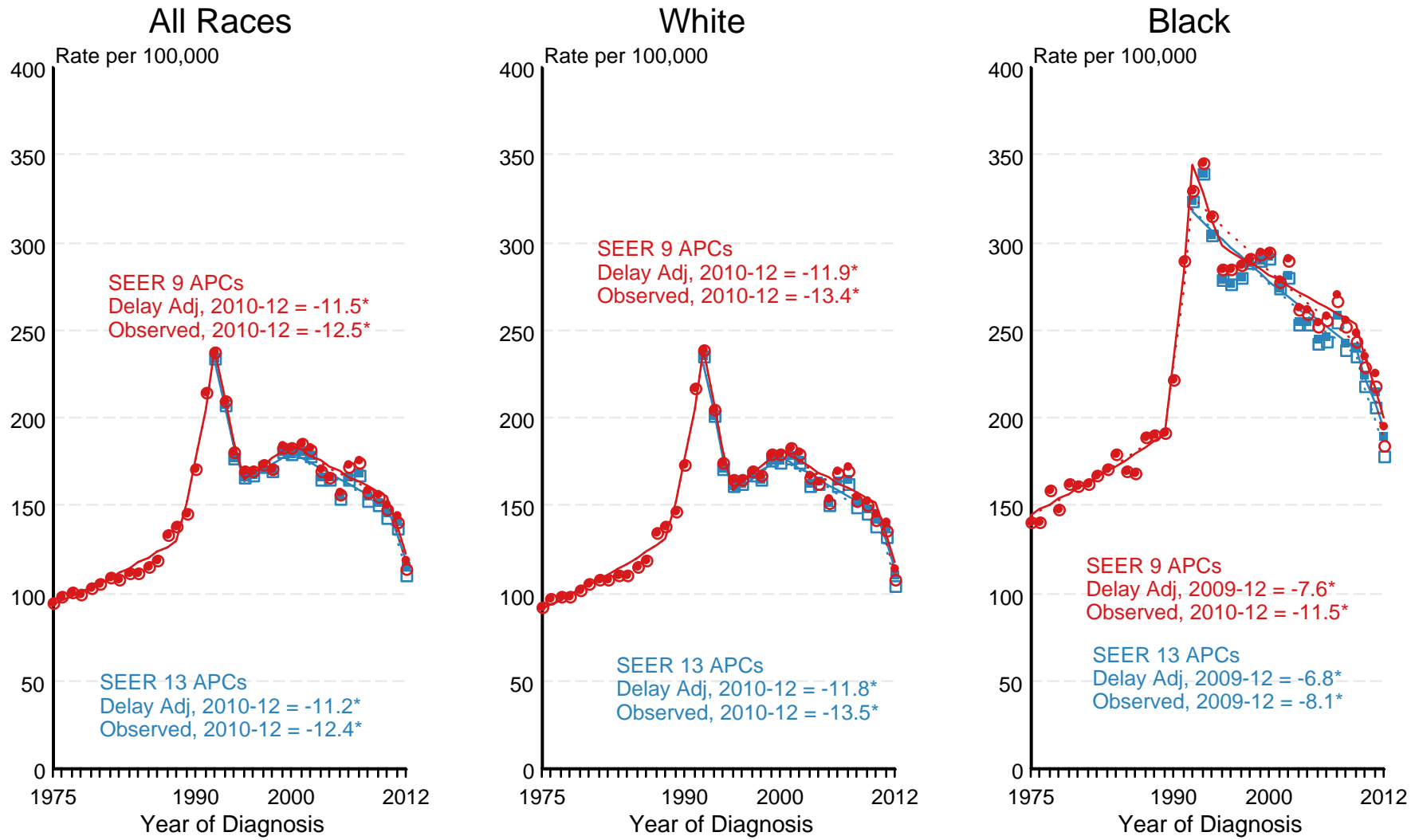
Delay-Adjusted Incidence Rates for Cancer of the Prostate and Cancer of the Lung and Bronchus All Races, Males 1975-2012

 □ SEER 13 Observed Incidence

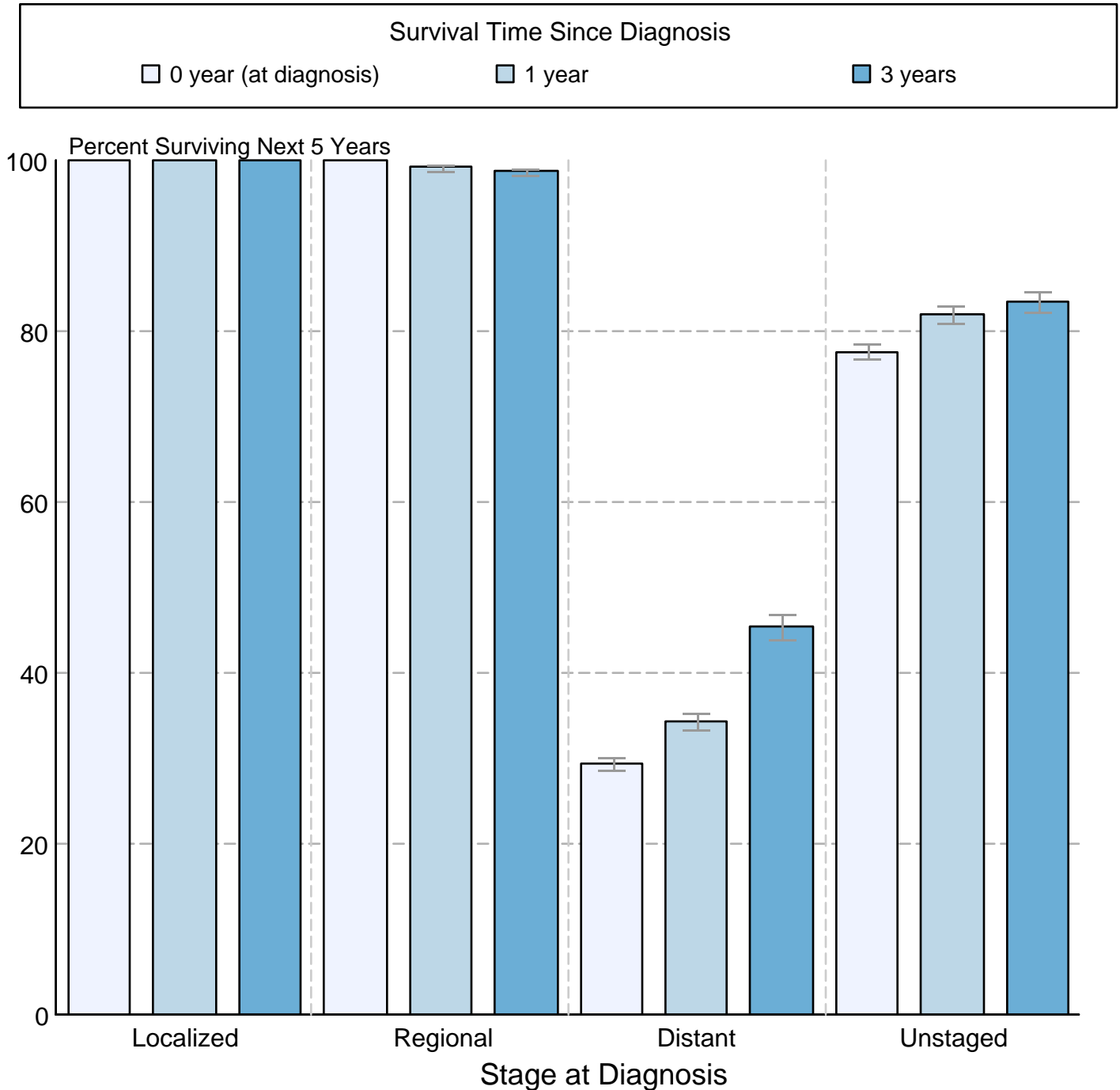
