Endometrioid adenocarcinoma with squamous differentiation is coded 8570 [Adenocarcinoma with squamous metaplasia].

### History:

Code the Histology field to 8323/3 [mixed cell adenocarcinoma].

GYN tumors containing two or more of the following tumor elements are coded to the mixed histology 8323:

1. Serous
2. Mucinous
3. Endometrioid
4. Clear cell
5. Transitional cell (Brenner)
6. Squamous cell.
